India approves third Moon Mission months after landing failure



India's Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle Mk III-M1 blasts off carrying Chandrayaan-2 from the Satish Dhawan space centre at Sriharikota, July 22, 2019.

The Chandrayaan-3 mission will have a Lander and a rover, but not an orbiter, Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) Chairman K. Sivan told reporters at its headquarters in Bengaluru, according to an official telecast. The Chandrayaan-2 mission in September successfully deployed a lunar orbiter that relays scientific data back to earth, but was unable to place a rover on the lunar surface after a hard landing. That mission had aimed to land on the south pole of the moon, where no other lunar mission had gone before. The region is believed to contain water as craters in the region are largely unaffected by the high temperatures of the sun. ISRO had hoped to confirm the presence of water in the form of ice, first detected on its mission in 2008.

Chandrayaan-3 will have a similar configuration as the previous mission, Sivan said.

Only the United States, Russia and China have landed on the moon. Beijing's Chang'e-4 probe touched down on the far side of the moon last year, while Israel made an unsuccessful attempt to land its Beresheet spacecraft on the moon in April 2019. India's third lunar mission will likely to launch in 2020 and will cost less than its previous mission.

Sivan also said ISRO was making a "good progress" for its human space-flight mission slated for late 2021, adding that four astronauts had been picked for training, which will be planned later this month. The project, called Gaganyaan, would cost less than 100 billion rupees (\$1.4 billion), the government said in 2018. India has developed a reputation for pioneering affordable satellite launches and space missions. Its unmanned Mars mission in 2014 cost just \$74 million, less than the budget of the Hollywood space blockbuster "Gravity".

Kerala crime capital of India, Kochi most dangerous city

State Leaves Uttar Pradesh, Delhi Far Behind

New Delhi: These are one set of statistics Kerala will not be proud to own up to: God's own country, and not the badlands of north India, is the most crime-prone state, ahead of Uttar Pradesh and even Delhi.

The National Crime Records Bureau's (NCRB) latest figures show Kerala is the most unsafe place in India.

Comparing incidents of crime with the population of a state, the NCRB has noted that Kerala is the most crime-prone state and Kochi the most dangerous city.

The NCRB figures (compiled till 2010) show that the state has a crime rate of 424.1, more than double the national average crime rate of 187.6. The crime rate in Kochi is scarier, clocking 1879.8 compared to most cities where the same figure averages to 341.9. In NCRB's figures, Kochi also saw an exponential rise of 193% in crime compared to 2009.

Crime rate - number of crimes committed per one lakh population - gives a more realistic picture of the



law and order situation of place than just the number of offences registered in a state or city. In a state with a larger population, the number of offences are naturally high compared to a small state but that does not necessarily make the larger state a lawless one.

Among states with significant population and area, Kerala has in fact left most far behind with Madhya Pradesh coming a distant second at 297.2 offences per one lakh population and Delhi at third with a rate of 279.8. UP, much reviled on law and order front, has a crime rate of only 87.5.

Kerala also ranks highest

on incidents of rioting and arson with a rate of 26 compared to national average of 6.4 even though Bihar (at 8,809 incidents) accounts for almost 13% of all riots in the country.

To put these figures in perspective, the NCRB has also compiled separate statistics for violent crimes that include murder, attempt to murder, rape, kidnapping and dowry death.

On this front too, Kerala's figures are way too high inspiring little confidence in the state's law and order machinery.

Of the 2,41,986 incidents of violent crimes in the country,

Kerala accounted for 11,756, more than much larger states like Rajasthan (10,577) and comparable to its neighbours Tamil Nadu (12,333) and Andhra Pradesh (12,491). UP accounts for highest number of violent crimes with 27,225 incidents.

Even women are not very safe in Kerala. The state's rate of crime against women hovers at 27, even higher than Delhi (24.6) which is often called the most unsafe place for women. Bihar, incidentally, is one of the safest for women recording a crime rate (against women) of only 8.7 - second only to Goa with a rate of 8.
